STATEMENT OF RESIDENCY OR EXEMPTION FOR PURPOSE OF OBTAINING AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE

I. <u>Statement of Residency</u>. To procure automobile insurance, I hereby attest that I am a resident of the State of New Hampshire. I understand that if I falsely claim to be a resident of the State of New Hampshire, I am subject to prosecution, imprisonment of up to one year and a fine of \$2,000.

II. Definition of Resident.

- (a) A person who maintains his or her true, fixed and permanent residence within New Hampshire and does not claim a residence in any other state for any purpose; or
- (b) A person who maintains a permanent place of abode in New Hampshire for the entire year and has actually spent more than 183 days in New Hampshire during the previous calendar year.

I also understand that this statement will be relied upon in connection with future renewals of the automobile insurance policy for which I am applying, and that it is my responsibility to inform my insurance company if I cease to be a New Hampshire resident.

III.Statement of Exemption. I hereby claim exemption from the residency requirement because (check one): the motor vehicle to be insured is garaged exclusively in New Hampshire; or

I am on active duty in the military service of the United States, am currently stationed in New Hampshire and the vehicle to be insured is currently garaged in this state.

I understand that this document will be relied upon in connection with future renewals of the automobile insurance policy for which I am applying, and that it is my responsibility to inform my insurance company if I cease to qualify for this exemption.
